Dear Parents, Caregivers, and Teachers

Through Good Samaritan Parish Catholic Primary School, you participate in a vital part of the life and work of our Lumen Christi Parish. The goal of Catholic education is focused on growth and improvement in faith, learning and wellbeing. Growth in faith particularly relates to the knowledge and skills that develop your child's mind and heart within a supportive community of faith, prayer, and loving service. Given the importance of this task for your child, it is vital that we listen to your voice as we develop our Parish Pastoral Plan.

As a parish school community, I invite you to join me in prayerful reflection on the riches of Christ that are in you and in our parish school


community. To discover these riches will give us hope in the love of Christ and confidence that we have much to offer for the growth of our school and parish life.

The aim of the Pastoral Plan is to develop our goals over the next five years to develop our:

- Community Life
- Worship as a community of faith and service
- **Mission** in bearing witness to Christ's truth and love
- Parish Support through our Parish Staff
- Stewardship of our facilities and properties

The first three steps in formulating the Pastoral Plan will occur on the following dates and I personally invite you to participate:

- On 19 February 2023 (7th Sunday in Ordinary Time) and 26 February 2023 (First Sunday of Lent), the Sunday homily will reflect on the theme "the riches of the glory of this mystery, which is Christ in you", to help everyone reflect on our gifts and how they can contribute to our parish.
- On 5 March 2023 (Second Sunday of Lent)
  we will distribute a survey asking for your
  suggestions about how we can develop
  the key areas of parish life. The survey will
  be presented by a member of the Pastoral
  or Finance Councils to each of our four
  local communities.
- After this Lenten period of reflection, the Pastoral and Finance Councils will consult with Bishop Mascord to finalise and publish the Pastoral Plan on 10 December 2023 (Second Sunday of Advent).

Thank you for your consideration and your contribution to the Good Samaritan Catholic school community and our Lumen Christi Parish. Through preparing our Pastoral Plan may we see how the riches of Christ in us can help us build our life together as the Body of Christ.
